



## Bio Instructions

- Bios should be three to four lines in small print. Longer bios will be edited.
- The body should be written in the third party (e.g. he/she, his/her).
- Start with First Name, Last Name followed by your role in parentheses, i.e. Susie Smith (Oompa Loompa).
- Please turn in your bio to the Bio folder located in the Moore theater.
- Spell out Sacred Heart School the first time it appears, SHS thereafter.
- Numbers, such as grade or age should be written out (seventh grade instead of 7th grade).
- Shows included should have the role in parentheses, e.g. Annie Jr. (Annie).
- If this is your first show or you do not have much theatrical experience that is okay. Let people know it is your debut on stage. Let them know what you like to do outside the theater or how you came to be involved in the theater. Thank those that encouraged you to try the theater, or helped you prepare for the play. If you have taken voice, dance or acting lessons, feel free to include that.
- If you have a long list of shows you will need to pick the most meaningful shows or most significant roles that you have had.
- Remember that you are sharing yourself with the audience in your bio and that you are representing not only you, but your family, Playmakers and Sacred Heart School as well. Sample Bios (These are just samples - do not make yours just like these, or they all look/sound the same.)
