



JUBILEE REACH FOOD PROGRAM REVISED FOR THE FALL

Beginning Tuesday, September 1st, 2020

(No end date scheduled yet)

Sacred Heart Parish has been providing groceries to Jubilee Reach since April. Due to the continued demand for families for food, this program will continue but with some modifications. Just ONE bag of groceries will be donated at a lesser cost than at present, approximately \$20-\$25 per week, and all the contents will be non-perishable. Families will come once a week to pick up their groceries which will be supplemented by USDA boxes of perishable foods.

• Church shoppers will provide:

- o One grocery bag
- o Dollar value of about \$20 (\$25 max.)
- o Non-perishables, which are not in the food box.
- o Two rolls of toilet paper
- o One rotating hygiene item: toothpaste, shampoo, bar soap, etc.
- o Delivered directly to Jubilee REACH in the morning, 9am-12pm
- o Churches will be asked to commit to bringing a set amount of groceries, Tue, Wed or Thu, much like is done now. Targeting about 200 per day to begin

Staffing First 6 Weeks

- For the first six weeks of Version 2, the operation will continue to be run by Jubilee staff.

Volunteers

- Beginning October 13, the operations will be run primarily by volunteers.
- There will be six shifts weekly: Tue AM & PM, Wed AM & PM, Thu AM & PM
- Shifts will likely be 9:00am-12:30pm and 12:00pm-3:30pm
- AM Shift will receive incoming food boxes and grocery bags, as well as do many program associated tasks
- PM Shift will distribute food boxes and grocery bags to families, as well as do many program associated tasks

- Goal is to bring people closer to the heart of this program, which is understanding better the issues these families face and how all of us can love them through it
- Orientation would be held at the shift beginning and a debrief would be held after the shift to help shape the experience toward this goal
- Churches will be able to 'claim' a shift, which will have 6-8 people on it
- The church will find the people to staff the shift

A Jubilee staff person will onboard all the volunteers through the normal volunteer process, which includes COVID paperwork and a background check

to lighten the burden for others.
